


Thank you for your interest in becoming a Volunteer at The Texas Zoo.

How it Works:

Once your application is sent in and processed, you will be contacted to schedule an interview and if selected, attend a general orientation before volunteer shifts begin. For the safety of our animals and staff/volunteers, new youth volunteers are recommended to get a tetanus booster and TB test before volunteer shifts begin. Volunteer Orientation training will take place once a month and area specific training will be scheduled as needed. A parent/guardian must be present at orientation to sign a release form on the youth's behalf. Volunteers will be required to make a commitment to volunteer **a minimum of 12 hours a month** after trainings have been completed.
